CREATING A CONTEXT AND A CULTURE FOR REVISION IN THE CLASSROOM

This open institute program is for teachers who have participated in a previous SDAWP professional development experience or who have experience using mentor text in the classroom. Using personal writing as a catalyst for understanding writing and revision, participants will:

- explore mentor texts and student writing as tools for revision possibilities
- learn to differentiate between meaning/correctness and revision/editing
- experiment with a variety of revision strategies throughout the writing process
- examine the value of choice to encourage student engagement during revision
- identify ways to support all writers (including ELLs, GATE, and struggling students)
