WHO SHOULD APPLY? The SI is designed for educators with 3 years of teaching experience (or educational equivalent), K-college, who have experience with teaching writing and a desire to learn more. Applicants should have an interest in becoming part of a professional community of practitioners. All grade levels and disciplines are invited to apply, including teachers of math, science, English, art, social studies/humanities, English Language Development, music, PE, special education, and foreign language. Participants will explore the impact race, language, poverty, and privilege have on equity in teaching and learning. Successful completion of the SI offers opportunities for ongoing collaboration, professional development, and a variety of leadership roles.
